Sub: Mandating GPS in ECMP/UCL client


This office O.M. No. 4(4)/57/122/2012-E&U-UIDAI dated 2nd March, 2016 regarding mandating inline scanning of resident enrolment documents (Pol, PoA and DoB etc.) and GPS, may be referred.

2. The ECMP enrolment client has a feature of attaching STQC certified GPS device. The system has been designed to make the same mandatory through Sync process. The capture of Latitude and Longitude using GPS enables control on movement of machines, and help implement geo-fencing and thereby enhance security of the enrolment process.

3. For strengthening security of the enrolment system, Registrars and Enrolment Agencies are hereby required to start using GPS with immediate effect. It is also hereby decided to make GPS mandatory in all the ECMP Client w.e.f 1st March 2017. Any ECMP machine not having GPS will cease to work after the 1.3.2017.

4. It may be noted that after 1.3.2017 waiver from GPS will be granted only in exceptional cases for not more than a month subject to a non-compliance penalty of Rs 25 per Aadhaar Generation deductible from the assistance payable to Registrars.

5. This issues with the approval of CEO, UIDAI.
