Subject: National Workshop on Aadhaar Ecosystem at Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh on 4-5th July 2016 – Reg.

Sir/Madam,

As you are aware, the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) has issued Aadhaar numbers to more than 102 crore residents of this country so far and efforts are on to cover the rest of the population soon. The Aadhaar architecture has been designed and put in place to facilitate integration of Aadhaar into various services/benefits delivered to the targeted population by the Government of India and also the State Governments. Already, the utility of Aadhaar, as a tool to bring in transparency and efficiency in administration of various beneficiary target schemes like transfer of LPG subsidy, distribution of commodities under PDS scheme, pensions to the old aged and needy has been proved on a wider scale. Various State Governments and Departments of the Government of India have been making use of Aadhaar and services offered by the Aadhaar Architecture like e-KYC, authentication, APB etc. recording considerable savings.

Keeping in view of the above successful endeavours and the recently passed Aadhaar (*Targeted Delivery of Financial and Other Subsidies, Benefits and Services*) Act, 2016, the emphasis in the near future is going to be on the use of Aadhaar for targeted delivery of benefits, services and subsidies to the entitled population in an efficiently and transparent manner. In this light, it has been decided to hold a two day National Workshop on **4th & 5th July, 2016 at Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh** to showcase the success stories on integration of Aadhaar into implementation of popular programmes like PDS, Social Security Pensions, MNREGS, Scholarships to Students and other such schemes implemented by various State Governments as well as some of the Departments of Government of India. As the State of Andhra Pradesh has been a front-runner in successfully integrating Aadhaar and using various services offered by the Aadhaar platform in the administration of social welfare schemes, PDS etc., it will be a good learning experience for all the States to have a first-hand experience by interacting with the grassroots functionaries and beneficiaries through field-visits that are being organized as part of the workshop. Also, experience sharing by various States and field functionaries is being organized in the workshop.
