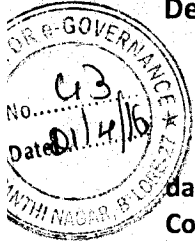

Dear Sri Jadhav

As you may be aware that Aadhaar numbers have been assigned to more than 98.8 crore residents in the country. Aadhaar saturation amongst adult population has reached 92%. While registering entities like NGOs, Corporations, Limited Corporations, Propriety Firms, Registered Societies and Trusts across the country, it may be useful to collect Aadhaar number of Individuals associated with them **on voluntary basis** along with other details. This will help in cleansing databases of entities and will bring transparency in their Registration process.

2. Accordingly, it is requested that the State Governments and Union Territory Administrations may issue suitable instructions to the Registrar of Societies/Charity Commissioners/Registrars of Cooperative Societies/Other regulatory authorities under their jurisdiction for obtaining Aadhaar number of individuals **on voluntary basis** who are associated with the NGOs/Cooperative Societies/Trusts during the fresh/renewal of registrations. This would facilitate easier verification of the individuals and expeditious approval of their applications.

3. A copy of the instruction so issued by the State Governments/UTs may be shared with us for record. UIDAI will provide the technical support for on-boarding of the Registrar of Societies/Charity Commissioners for Aadhaar based authentication.
