The Consultant Evaluation of the Karnataka Evaluation Authority (KEA) welcomed the Chairperson, secretary, Planning, members of the technical Committee, the representatives of line department and consultant organisation who were present in the meeting. The following were the discussions and decisions:

**1. Evaluation study of "Sakala" programme of the Government of Karnataka**

The Chairperson sought the opinion of DPAR (AR) in response to letter dated: 05.12.2014 addressed by KEA to the Director SAKALA regarding acceptability of report.

The reply of DPAR (AR) to the letter of KEA dated: 5-12-2014, and specific points there in yet to be received in KEA. Thereafter, further action can be taken to place it before the next Technical Committee Meeting.

**2. Evaluation of "Suvarna Gothali Samrakshna Yojane"**

- a. The representatives of the department explained briefly about the objective of scheme, which is mainly to preserve the indigenous cattle breeds as these breeds are not economically viable and hence their numbers are decreasing.
- b. The committee was of the opinion that creation of awareness conservation and preserving the gene pool cannot be done without full participation of public. It was informed to the committee that there is decline in the indigenous cattle population from 2007 livestock census to that of 2012. The Chairperson directed the department representatives to

furnish district wise names of NGOs and 6 types of indigenous breeds developed.

- c. As per the sampling methodology drawn in the ToR one NGO in each Revenue Division is to be selected. The Chairperson suggested that the sampling is to be done in such a way that all the 6 indigenous breeds are represented while doing so. The consultant organization was apprehensive about increase in the cost for the study if this is done. Therefore, KEA and the department to sit again and work on the sampling methodology after getting information from department on district wise names of NGOs/6 types of indigenous breeds.
- d. The Chairperson suggested the consultant organization to include one more schedule on FGDs with farmers as schedule 'F' so that frequency of visits by the department can also be corroborated with farmers replies and a schedule on complying with all the conditions stipulated in the MoU by NGO while getting the benefit of the scheme as per Government Order No. AHF 53 ಪಪಾಯೋ 2006 dated: 19.12.2006.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to all present.
