

**Sub:** Selection of Consultant Evaluation Organization for carrying out the evaluation study of "*Evaluation of Utilization of Individual Household Latrines*" on Quality cum Cost Basis election (QCBS) through e-tender process.

**FACTS ON WHICH THE DECISION IS BASED**

1. Vide e-tender notification cited as reference 1, bids were called from Consultant Evaluation Organizations for carrying out the evaluation study of "*Evaluation of Utilization of Individual Household Latrines*" on Quality cum Cost Basis Selection (QCBS) method as detailed in Chapter VI-A of the Karnataka Transparency in Public Procurement Rules 2000.

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2. Functionally synonymous with the meaning of the term as in rule 20 of the Karnataka Transparency in Public Procurement Rules 2000, two Tender Evaluation Committees were constituted. The first one, which was done vide reference 2 was to –

- (A) Evaluate Part I of the Technical Proposal in case of Non-empaneled Consultant Evaluation Organizations and in accepting the scores of the Empanelment Committee of KEA in case of KEA Empaneled Consultant Evaluation Organizations, and,  
(B) Evaluate Part II A of the Technical Proposal.

The second Tender Evaluation Committee was formed vide reference 3 with the function of evaluating Part II B of the Technical Proposal and the Financial Proposal. This Committee included Sri. Jagadeesh, Consultant, of the State Water and Sanitation Mission, Bengaluru, along with two members of the Karnataka Evaluation Authority (KEA).

3. The aforecited two Committees have processed the tenders in accordance with the tender conditions and submitted a report dated 08<sup>th</sup> January 2016. In the said report, the scores of the bidding Consultant Evaluation Organizations whose bids were valid have been provided by the second cited Tender Evaluation Committee, and is enclosed as the annexure to these proceedings for reference. According to this annexure, the Consultant Evaluation Organization *M/s Core Carbon X Solutions Private Limited, Hyderabad*, has scored the highest and qualified to be called H1 as described in clause 5.7 of the tender. Their financial quote is **Rs. 1950000 [Rupees Nineteen Lakh Fifty Thousand only]** (inclusive of all taxes), which has been recommended to be accepted.

I have perused the documents, scores and processes followed by the Committees and found them to be in accordance with the tender conditions and processes prescribed by the Karnataka Transparency in Public Procurement Act 1999 and Rules 2000. In view of these, the following –

**DECISIONS**

1. In the exercise of financial authority number 1 of reference 4, vested in the Chief Evaluation Officer of Karnataka Evaluation Authority, the best rate of **Rs. 1950000 [Rupees Nineteen Lakh Fifty Thousand only]**, inclusive of all taxes], quoted by **M/s Core Carbon X Solutions Private Ltd, 5R, 'A' Block, Kanthishikara Complex, 6-3-668/9, Punjagutta, Hyderabad-500 082**, is accepted for carrying out the Evaluation of **"Utilization of Individual Household Latrines"** following the tender and QCBS processes and the Karnataka Transparency in Public Procurement Act 1999 and Rules 2000.
  1. The acceptance is subject to all tender conditions and further those which may be directed by the General and/or Governing body of the KEA.
  2. In accordance with condition number 7.2 of Section II of the tender, the Contract Agreement will be have to be entered into by or before the 09<sup>th</sup> of February 2016, lest it lapses as provided in the afore mentioned condition of there-tender.
  3. The EMD of **Rs. 25,000** of **M/s Core Carbon X Solutions Private Ltd** is to be retained and will be liable to be returned upon successful completion of contract. The EMDs of all other bidders is refunded following due procedure.


